



SUSTAINABLE GUEST PRACTICES

At Tamborine Mountain Glades, we're committed to protecting the rainforest, wildlife and waterways that make this place so special. Every guest plays a part in keeping our environment healthy. Here's how you can help:

WASTE SEPARATION

We operate a site-wide waste separation system. This helps us reduce waste by ensuring everything that can be recycled gets recycled in the best way possible!

IN YOUR ROOMS THERE WILL BE A WASTE BIN AND A 10C CONTAINER BIN.

Throughout the park please separate your waste in the following

- 10¢ Containers- Green Bins- Place cans and eligible plastic and glass drink containers marked with the 10¢ refund symbol. All funds raised through the Containers for Change program are donated to Wildcare Australia Inc.
- Mixed Recycling- Yellow Bins- Paper, cardboard (clean and dry), glass jars/bottles, rigid plastics, aluminium and steel.
- General Waste- Red Bins - Items that can't be recycled here, such as soft plastics or contaminated packaging.

Please hand any batteries to staff at Reception for safe disposal.

ENERGY & WATER USE

Small actions make a big difference.

- Turn off lights, heating/cooling and appliances when you leave your room.
- Set air conditioning around 23-24°C for both comfort and efficiency.
- Take shorter showers and turn taps off fully.
- Please report any leaks or maintenance issues to Reception straight away.
- Choose to reuse towels and linen to help reduce water and energy from laundry.

PROTECTING WILDLIFE & COUNTRY

Our rainforest has a biodiverse range of flora and fauna (plants and wildlife!) To help protect their homes please:

- Stay on marked paths – this protects you, as well as regenerating habitats.
- Do not feed wildlife – human food makes animals sick and can change their natural behaviour. We have a free daily bird feeding session at 2pm!
- Keep noise low near nests and waterways.
- Leave what you find – rocks, plants, feathers and other natural objects should remain in place.
- Safe Sunscreen- Please help keep our creek happy and healthy by choosing reef-safe sunscreen – skip ones with oxybenzone and octinoxate.

CAMPFIRES & SAFETY

- Fires are only allowed in designated fire pits and must follow current fire restrictions.
- Never leave a fire unattended and ensure it is completely out with water before leaving.
- If you see hazards (wildlife in distress, damaged tracks, overflowing bins), please let our friendly team know!
- Firewood is available for purchase at reception!

SMALL ACTS, BIG IMPACT

- Refill & Reuse – bring or reusable water bottle and coffee cup (The Terrace Cafe offers a discount for BYO coffee cups!).
- Travel Lightly – use walking trails, the local shuttle, or car-share with your group to reduce traffic and emissions.
- Shuttle Service- To reduce traffic onsite please ask our reception team about our onsite electric buggy shuttle service.
- Give Back – our purchases onsite all have an opt-out 1% donation to Tamborine Mountain Landcare. Recycle your bottles and cans in the designated bins to donate to Wildcare Australia Inc.
